Chamber offers Workers Compensation discount

Business owners who want to maximize your workers' compensation premium, then you need to look at joining a safety council in your area. Most Ohio employers are eligible to lower their workers' compensation premiums by 4% for the July 1, 2006 to June 30, 2007 rating year by participating in one of the 74 safety councils located around the state.

A business can qualify for the Safety Council discount by following these four simple steps. First, enroll with your local safety council by September 30, 2006. To find the safety council in your area contact the local Chamber of Commerce or visit the BWC website at ohiobwc.com. Second the employer must send a representative to at least 8 monthly meeting from July, 2006 to June 30, 2007. Third, a qualified senior-level manager must attend a safety council CEO event. Finally, the business has to submit semiannual workplace accident reports for the 2006 calendar year.

In addition to the 4% premium discount you will obtain valuable information on how to better manage your workers' compensation program, increase safety awareness in your workplace, and network with other employers in your community.
